



Event Attendance



Be prepared to quickly and efficiently record student attendance at any event and, if needed, manage the dismissal of students to a verified contact. Integrate the Event Attendance module into your district's Reunification response plan.

Event Attendance

Staff can record ad hoc or predefined attendance events for students. Fire or other drills, on a bus, or at events such as field trips, athletic events, pep rallies, or any other district event can be a defined event. Checkpoints can be identified and periodically used to update Realtime keeping track of students who are still present, as they depart, arrive at a checkpoint location, return, or are released to a verified contact. The authorized contact that the student was released to and the staff that released them can be tracked and reported.

Reunification

In the event of an evacuation, reuniting students with an authorized contact is essential. When a Reunification Event is triggered, all students at a location become attached to an evacuation event. All device equipped staff can then record that students are present at a checkpoint. Administrators can view total students, students that have not been accounted for, students that are not present that day, and students that have been released to an authorized contact.

Mobile Integration

Activate the mobile Staff App to maximize the number of staff using Event Attendance to take mobile student attendance during an Attendance Event, particularly a Reunification Event. Staff at a Checkpoint location can scan student IDs with a mobile device. Students can be added, updated, annotated, and released to verified contacts all from the mobile Staff App. Medical warnings will be displayed as necessary.

Being Prepared

Event Templates can be predefined for staff and students for recurring events such as athletic practices or games. Templates for Reunification drills may also be defined and maintained in advance to be prepared in the event of an emergency.
