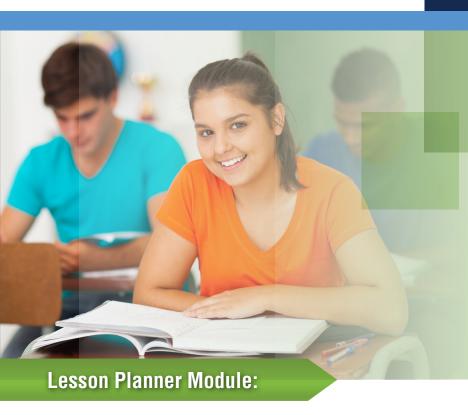


## Lesson Planner

## The Lesson Planner includes powerful tools:

- A suite of functions to develop daily and unit plans in individual, department, or district defined formats.
- Text boxes, such as Objective, Essentials, Assessment, etc. are available for each component of the teacher's plan to allow for organization and easy analysis.
- Full word processor functionality is included.
- Pictures can be included, and files can be attached to a lesson plan.

- Assignments created within the lesson plan can post automatically to the Gradebook and to the Parent Portal's Gradebook and Calendars tabs.
- Several views of the weekly plans can be printed or exported in a Word format. Plans can be viewed individually, by day, by section, or by an entire week in subject or calendar format.
- The Lesson Planner automatically pre-fills courses and sections from the Master Schedule sections.
- For Elementary Schools a calendar view allows subjects and activities to be dragged to the appropriate day and time frame.
- Supervision can approve/disapprove individual lesson plans, or entire weeks of plans and attach appropriate comments or notes to each.

## **Lesson Planner**

This powerful tool facilitates the development of daily and unit lesson plans, correlation with the Core Curriculum Standards, lesson plan sharing and co-development, curriculum warehousing, and a seamless connection to the Gradebook, Student, and Parent Portals.

- Approved lesson plans can be archived in a library to be later recalled by keyword or standard.
- Purchased lesson plans can be posted to the district library for distribution to staff.
- There is an area to record teacher reflection on a given lesson.
- Sharing allows teachers to work together to develop lessons with supervisory approval.
- Team or inclusion teachers can share in the co-development of lessons. Modifications can be highlighted in a contrasting color or background.
- Teacher, department, and district templates may be developed for each text block in the Lesson Planner to ensure consistency across users.
